Javier Ordóñez is Full Professor of International Economics at the Jaume I University, where he heads up the Institute of International Economics (IEI). He is president of the Spanish Association of International Economics and Finance (AEEFI). Professor Ordóñez received a PhD in Economics (cum laude) from Jaume I University, with European Doctorate accreditation. He holds a MSc in Economics and Finance from the University of Warwick, UK.

He has taught at the University of Bath in the United Kingdom and has been assistant research professor of Prof. Katarina Juselius at the University of Copenhagen in Denmark, and has also been a visiting professor at the University of Nottingham, the University of Bologna, the University of Paris 13, the Sapienza University of Rome, the University of Sheffield and the KDI of Public Policy and Management, among others.

His key research interests are economic integration, time series econometrics, and unemployment, although he has also published papers in the field of energy economics and regional economics. He has published numerous articles in JCR-indexed journals such as Empirical Economics, Economic Modeling, Review of International Economics, Energy Economics, Energy Journal, China Economic Review, International Review of Economics and Finance, Energy, Plos One, Open Economies Review, Empirica, and Regional Studies, among others, and has contributed chapters to books published by MIT University Press, Routledge and Palgrave Macmillan. He has been guest editor of Economic Modeling, The Energy Journal, and the The World Economy and he is editor of Plos One and The Asian Journal of Economics and Finance.
